I hope you all had a wonderful celebration of Christmas and New Year! The board of LUO greatly values the display of your love and support throughout the crisis that LUO had encountered in the last 2-3 months. Your prayers most significantly carried us through. Our ministry team at the local front (in Honan, small town in Isabel, Leyte, Philippines) has also been strengthened as we ALL join hands in doing His Work. For that, we are deeply grateful and thankful to our dear Lord God for each one of you!

Ministry Updates

Right now, the LUO Rebuilding Project has begun. Unfortunately, due to another storm that struck the same region on January 8, work was placed on hold temporarily. The plan is to rebuild the structures (2 classrooms, kitchen/dining area and restroom) that have been destroyed by typhoon Haiyan. There is also a plan to build a multi-purpose building to hold fellowship & ministry services in the future, upon availability of funds and God's direction. *Please keep this endeavor in your prayers.*

The attendance of the children participating in LUO's programs has increased significantly since the start of our relief operation on November 26. From 25 average attendees in November 2, LUO now is caring and mentoring over 60+ children. We are so thankful for the opportunity to serve more children, and we just hired an additional teacher on January 1st to meet the growing needs of the ministry.

Two typhoon relief operations were successful when 100 and 200 packages were delivered on Nov 26 and Dec 7 respectively. Not only families of LUO children benefited from these efforts, but also the elderly, infant and very poor people in the local community.

Evangelism and Prayer Focus

Our primary focus is still about sharing the deep love of our Lord Jesus Christ to all children who attends LUO. We are very excited and we know that you are praying with us and for us about seeing God's Glory and His Purposes being accomplished in this small community where LUO ministry is. We have no doubt that this is His Mission and the Work is His!
